

There are a number of issues and questions pertaining to glass. We are not the experts but we have been asked the same questions on numerous occasions and thought we would share the information with you.

Q. Can Scratched Glass be repaired?

A. Typically, scratches in glass are the result of foreign debris or dirt on the glass. If care is not taken to lightly flush and remove the debris it can and probably will etch the glass surface resulting in scratches.

WINDOWKING does not sell a scratch remover but there are companies that remove scuffs, light scratches and deposits on the glass that can't be cleaned with regular window cleaners.

Sommer and Maca Industries offer a product called Rare Earth, which is a cleaning compound for glass. Many glass suppliers have this product or you can call Sommer and Maca Industries, order department at 1-800-323-9200. Follow the directions carefully. WINDOWKING is not responsible for any damage cause by the use or misuse of this product or other damage that could happen in trying to remove scratches.

**Use what the pro's use:**

It has been brought to our attention that many new automobile dealers use toothpaste to clean the windows of used cars.

1. Use a damp cloth and toothpaste for glue, pitch, and other less harsh contaminates.
2. Apply toothpaste to damp cloth and buff in a circular motion until clean. Do not let the toothpaste.
